The Sounders face two critical matches this week, with every point earned or given up meaningful to their effort to secure a playoff spot. With three regular season games left, the Sounders are in 3rd place, having snatched 3 points from the Whitecaps on Sunday with a 1-0 win in Vancouver, gaining critical ground in the Western Conference. The victory tied the Sounders with the Minnesota Thunder in third place at 37 points. The Thunder still have two games in hand, but play the next five games on the road to finish the season. The Thunder have yet to win a match on the road all season.

The season series between these two clubs is now even at 1-1-1, both teams have scored one goal. The Whitecaps are on a six game winless streak going 0-3-3 since July 30th. All-time the Sounders are 29-16-12 against the Whitecaps.

On August 22nd the Sounders wrangle with the A-League expansion Puerto Rico Islanders (5-15-6, 21 pts.) at Qwest Field at 5pm. The Islanders feature talent from Central and South American countries including: Honduras, El Salvador, Brazil, Argentina and Puerto Rico. The weekend after the Sounders finish their season at home on August 28th, hosting the Minnesota Thunder.
